ICCA In-Person Meeting 2026: Location & Timing Options (For Discussion)

Proposed Location: Niagara Falls, Ontario

- Easy U.S. access via Buffalo (primary airport); Toronto or Hamilton airports are 1–2 hours away by car.
- Significant tourism options for guests or extended stays.
- Proximity to wine region; potential for ice wine vineyard tour.

Option A: August 24-28, 2026

Pros

- Week before the Farm Progress Show (lowa).
- Opportunity for peach harvest + automated packing line tour (harvest typically ends Sept 1).
- Falls after most U.S. school start dates, which may help families.

Considerations

- Canadian school year starts later (Sept 7), which may increase hotel/conference costs.
- Favorable USD-CAD exchange rate may help offset costs.

Option B: September 14-18, 2026

Pros

- Weather generally still excellent; **minimal harvest activity** underway (some corn silage/dry beans).
- Alternative location option: Windsor, Ontario (across from Detroit).
 - Strong vegetable production region (tomatoes, carrots, onions, sweet corn, peppers) for potential tours.
 - Access to another wine-producing area; vineyard tour possible (less scenic than Niagara).

Considerations

- Falls after a large Ontario farm show the previous week—minimal added draw for agronomists.
- Peach harvest tour not feasible in this window.
- Windsor has **fewer tourist attractions** compared to Niagara Falls.

Next Steps

- Chair proposes presenting these two options (timing + location) during the **December** meeting (5–10 minutes).
- Follow-up board survey after the call to determine preferences.
