## **Proposed Motion: Authorization for Proxy Voting by Board Chairs**

## **Motion:**

To authorize proxy voting for Certified Crop Adviser (CCA) program boards at the local, regional, and national levels under the following conditions:

- 1. A board chair who is unable to attend a scheduled board meeting may designate a proxy from their board to vote on their behalf.
- 2. The designated proxy is not required to hold CCA certification.
- 3. The board chair must provide written notice of the proxy designation to appropriate ASA staff (i.e., the Director of Governance and/or Associate Director of Component Relations) and the ICCA Executive Committee Chair, in advance of each meeting at which the proxy will serve.
- 4. The written notice must specify the name of the designated proxy and the date(s) of the meeting(s) for which the proxy authorization applies.
- 5. At the beginning of the meeting, the proxy must verbally declare that they are serving as proxy on behalf of the board chair.
- 6. The proxy's authority applies only for the duration of the meeting(s) identified in the written notice.

## Rationale:

This motion ensures continuity of board representation and decision-making when a chair is unable to attend a meeting, while maintaining transparency, proper documentation, and clear communication with ASA staff and the ICCA Executive Committee.
