

If you would like to register to peer review for multiple journals, this is welcomed. Unfortunately, you will need to register individually in ScholarOne with each journal title due to system limitations.


Step 1 After reaching the journal log-in page, click the 'Create an Account' button to begin.



To create an account, complete the requested information in the following three sections: email/name, address, and user ID & password. Please ensure that all required information is entered prior to selecting 'Next' on each screen.



Step 2 Please enter 2-5 keywords to represent your experience and expertise when creating your account. These keywords are used to connect reviewers to relevant manuscripts.



Step 3 Please email the Program Manager of the appropriate journal(s) with your name and contact information to notify us that you're interested in peer reviewing for the journal. We will contact you to follow up.
