- Promoting the CCA program to potential new CCAs and encouraging lapsed CCAs to reinstate their certifications.
- Streamlining communications and fostering strong connections with regional and national partners to support clear and effective program communication.
 - Managing new CCA applicant review packets and reviewing and approving requests for CCA CEUs.
- Developing the annual budget and managing event sponsorships, grant funding, and related financial reporting.
