Through this website, users are linked directly to information on and ways to engage with:

- DEI initiatives and statements of dozens of AGI Federation affiliates
- A framework that geoscience societies can use to cultivate inclusion, increase equity, and address intersectionality across race, class, disability status, and gender
- Scholarships supporting minority and female geoscience graduate students
- Various committees helping to coordinate the DEI efforts of AGI and the geoscience community
- Webinars exploring issues of DEI in the geosciences as well as recommendations for effectively addressing them
- Reports and related resources on strengthening diversity in geoscience higher education
- A website promoting girls and women in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics, including related education resources
