- **2022 ASA Board of Directors Representatives:** Biometry and Statistical Computing Section, Climatology and Modeling Section, Land Management and Conservation Section, and Graduate Student Board Representative
- **2022 CSSA Board of Directors Representatives:** Division C–3 Crop Ecology, Management & Quality; Division C–6 Forage & Grazinglands; Division C–7 Genomics, Molecular Genetics, and Biotechnology; and Graduate Student Board Representative
